
#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**



# **Step 1**Attach four Dumbbell Frames (3) onto the Base Frame (1) with eight M10x20 Bolts (4), sixteen Ø10 Washers (5), and eight M10 Nylon Nuts (6). Tighten the bolts and nuts with two Wrenches provided.

**Step 2**Attach the Top Frame (2) onto the Dumbbell Frames (3) with eight M10x20 Bolts (4), sixteen Ø10 Washers (5), and eight M10 Nylon Nuts (6). Tighten the bolts and nuts with two Wrenches provided.
